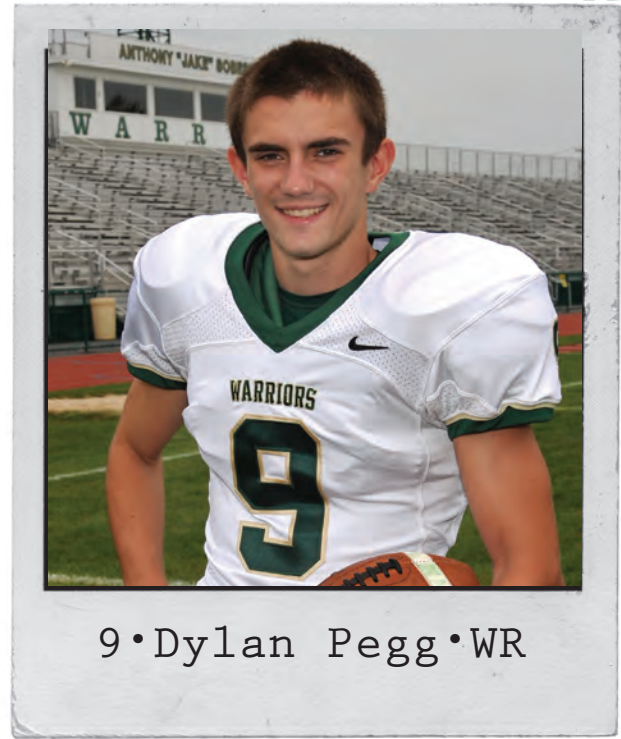
Zak was inspired to play football because of past Warrior players and Reggie Bush.

The best line from a coach would be the season slogan for 2010 "ALL IN".

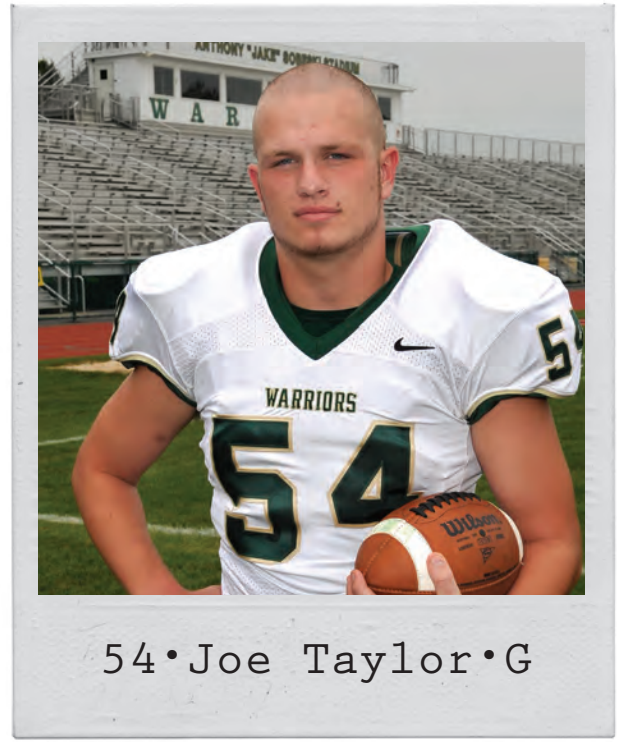
Cody's ABSOLUTE all time favorite WA football memory is catching the 91 yard TD from Zezza to break the school record. He also just doesn't get the "power pass".

Of all the plays in the WA playbook he can’t understand why Coach Spencer will not let him run the fly pattern. He is confident in his speed.

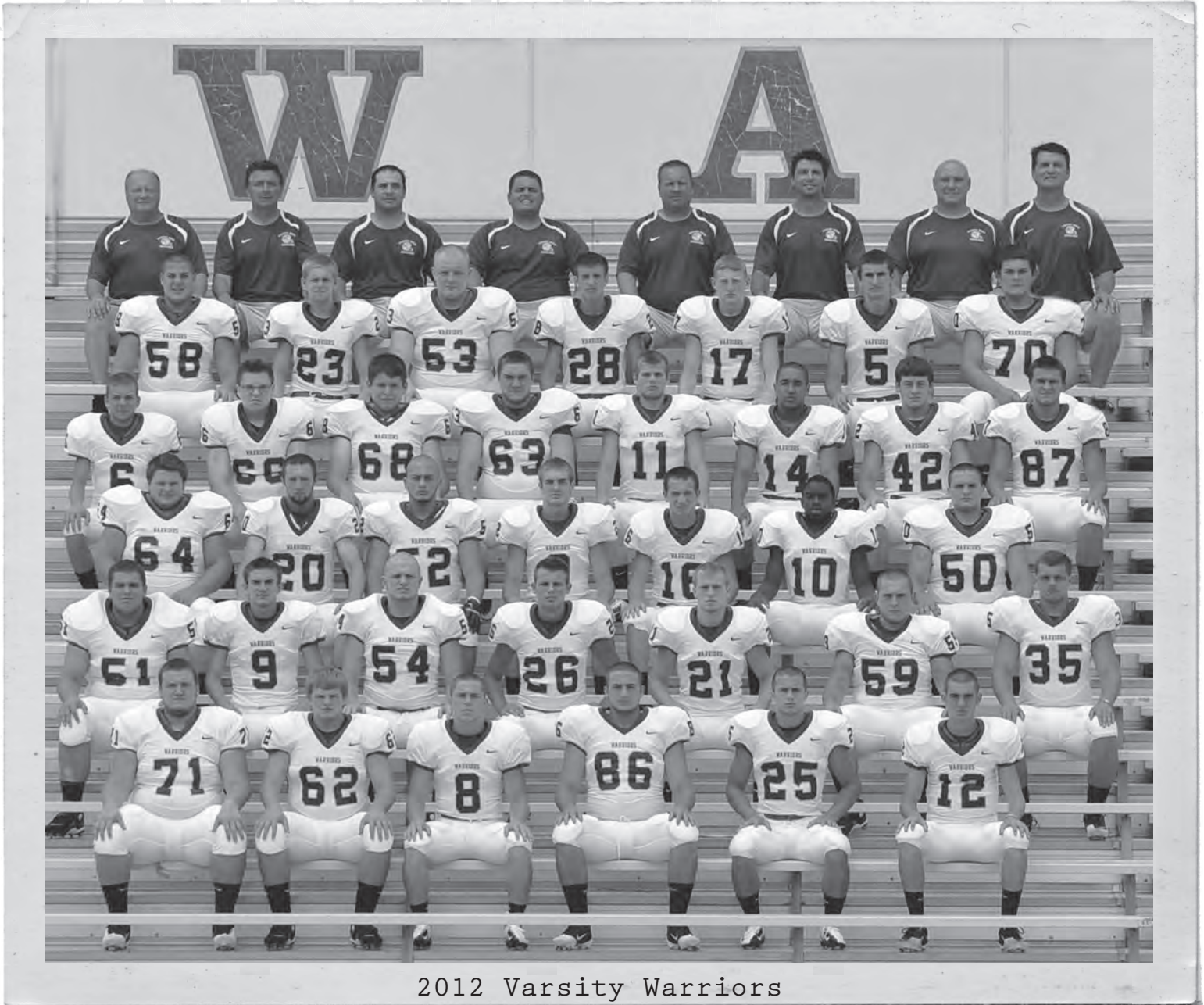
He chose # 71 because of one of the greatest linemen in NFL, which he hopes to be part of someday.
